POST-SURGERY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. DO NOT allow your pet to run, jump, or rough play with other pets for 7-10 days after surgery. We want the pet to remain as still and quiet as possible to promote quick healing.
- 2. DO NOT ALLOW THE INCISION SITE TO BECOME WET! This means no bathing, playing in water, or licking of the site for 7-10 days after the surgery.
 - The incision is closed externally with a glue adhesive, which may dissolve if it becomes too moist.
 - If licking becomes an issue, an e-collar, or plastic cone collar, can be purchased for \$10.00 any time the clinic is open. If you know your pet is prone to licking, we advise you to purchase an e-collar the day of surgery.
- 3. The incision site should remain flesh-toned without any swelling, redness, or discharge. If these issues occur, please call; we will gladly exam the incision site.
- 4. Your pet has been given a long lasting injection for pain, as well as an antibiotic. Do not give other medications to your pet. If you feel your pet is in pain, please call.
- 5. Feed your pet ¼ of its normal amount of food around 6:00 p.m. the night of surgery. A small amount of water is fine. No table scraps.
